PRESS CONFERENCE: Doctors to Tell Representative Cantor to Let Health Reform Move Forward

RICHMOND, VA – *Doctors for America's* Virginia State Director, Dr. Chris Lillis, along with other Doctors for America members will deliver a petition to Representative Cantor (R-VA) and hold a press conference outside his district office on Thursday, January 6th at 11:00 am EST. Doctors for America is delivering the petition to Representative Cantor to demonstrate physician and medical student support for the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. Doctors for America members are calling on Congressman Cantor to work with patients and providers to improve the health reform law – not repeal it.
