

Formulary of Highest-Enrollment Part D Plan Includes More Unique Chemical Compounds than VA National Formulary

A number of statements have been made about the comprehensiveness of VA formulary coverage in comparison to Part D formulary coverage. We have been asked by the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America to look at certain comparisons made of those formularies, in particular a presentation recently delivered at the American Enterprise Institute entitled “Overview of the VA Pharmacy Benefits Management Strategic Health Care Group (PBM).”¹ According to that presentation “VA dispenses 4,778 specific drug products which represent the 1,294 chemical compounds listed on the [Veterans Administration National Formulary or VANF].” The presentation further states that Medicare Part D formularies on average offer only 4,300 specific drugs reflecting 1,300 chemical compounds – 448 (11%) fewer specific drugs than the VANF.

These comparison figures are misleading in several respects. Subject to certain exclusions, Part D formularies generally are limited to drugs provided, by prescription, to a patient.² The VANF, however, includes a wide range of other items such as:

- Over-the-counter (OTC) drugs, such as aspirin, antacids and mineral oil, which can be obtained without a prescription;
- Certain prescription drugs specifically excluded from Part D, including barbiturates, benzodiazepines, cold and cough drugs, cosmetic drugs and others;
- Devices and other non-drug items, such as bandages and colostomy bags; and
- Drugs that are used only by providers in inpatient or ambulatory settings (many of which are in the form of intravenous (IV) solutions) but are not provided to patients themselves.

A list of the items that fall in these categories and are in the VANF appears under Tab A.

While prescription drug plans authorized under Part D do not cover these other types of drugs and devices, they may be covered by Part A or Part B of Medicare. Consequently, if the VANF as a whole is to be accurately compared to Medicare coverage, it should be compared to coverage under all of these programs and not to Part D alone. An apples to apples comparison would be a comparison of VANF coverage of outpatient prescription drugs covered under Part D to coverage of prescription drugs by formularies used by Part D plans. We therefore reviewed

² A Part D plan formulary generally is limited to “covered Part D drugs” which are defined to include: (i) A drug that may be dispensed only upon a prescription and that is described in sections 1927(k)(2)(A)(i) through (iii) of the Social Security Act (SSA); (ii) A biological product described in sections 1927(k)(2)(B)(i) through (iii) of the SSA; (iii) Insulin described in section 1927(k)(2)(C) of the SSA; (iv) The following medical supplies associated with the injection of insulin: syringes, needles, alcohol swabs, and gauze; or (v) A vaccine licensed under section 351 of the Public Health Service Act. Covered Part D drugs do not include any drugs that could be excluded from coverage under Section 1927(d)(2) of SSA other than smoking cessation agents or under Section 1927(d)(3). Also excluded are drugs that may be covered under Medicare Parts A and B. To simplify the analysis described here, vaccines and all medical supplies, regardless of use, were ignored in assessing both formularies.

the VANF formulary and the formulary of the Part D Plan with the highest enrollment (the plan is a national plan with a formulary available to all beneficiaries).

Based on the data contained in the November 2006 VA National Drug File (NDF), the VANF includes 581 unique chemical compounds that are used in prescription drugs (and not 1,294).³ In contrast, the formulary used by the Part D prescription drug plan (PDP) with the highest enrollment includes 1,003 such compounds – 422 (73%) more. A table comparing the VANF and Part D coverage appears under Tab B.

Summary: Coverage of Unique Chemical Compounds by VANF and Part D Plan with Highest-Enrollment Formulary

This comparison is consistent with a recent study by The Lewin Group that focused on VANF and Part D coverage of the 300 drugs with the highest prescription volume among individuals aged 65 and older. That study found that coverage of these drugs by the highest-enrollment Part D PDPs (averaging 282 drugs or 94%) was substantially better than VANF coverage (195 drugs or only 65%). A complete copy of this study appears under Tab C.

It is likely the VA presentation also overestimates the number of specific drug products that are on the VANF in contrast to Part D formularies. As noted, Tab A lists 516 unique chemical compounds that are excluded as not covered by Part D and so thus not on PDP formularies. It is unclear as to how many specific drug products these 516 unique chemical compounds would actually equate. For example, the VA tally of specific drug products appears to be a count of unique combinations of chemical compound, dosage, and form; however, it is ambiguous as to what level of distinction was used to define a “unique” drug product. Based on various combinations of information available from the fields in the NDF (e.g., generic name, VA product name, strength, dose form), a wide range of estimates for specific drug products can be derived. Also, it is unclear if packaging was used as a differentiating factor as well. For example, using the VA product name field, which is a combination of chemical compound, dosage strength, and form, single dose packages include a differentiating unit dose (UD) label in the product name as compared to bottles containing multiple pills. Thus, when comparing VA formulary coverage against a Part D formulary, the 4,778 count is likely an over-estimate based on the inclusion of non-drug products and other entities not covered by the Part D benefit in the VA’s method of counting chemical compounds. Due to the difficulty in matching up the specificity used to identify unique drug products, attempts to compare formulary coverage at this level of detail between the VANF and a Part D formulary are likely to be misleading.

³ Some chemical compounds are used both in prescription and in non-prescription drugs; for example, products containing acetaminophen (used in Tylenol) are OTC drugs at some dosages and but prescription drugs at others. In this analysis, a chemical compound was counted if any of the specific drugs based on the compound are prescription drugs.

Comparison of VA National Formulary and Formularies of Highest Enrollment Plans in Medicare Part D and the Federal Employee Health Benefit Program

Lewin was asked by the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America to compare the formulary status of drugs commonly used by the Medicare population on the Veterans Affairs National Formulary (VA formulary), the two highest enrollment Medicare Part D plans, and the plan with highest enrollment in the Federal Employee Health Benefit Program (FEHBP).

Methodology

Lewin identified the drugs most commonly used by the Medicare population by querying Verispan's Vector One Data (VONA) to compile the 300 drugs with the highest script volumes for the 65 and older population. The script volume for each drug is from the time period of January 2006 through October 2006.

We downloaded the VA's National Drug File from the VA pharmacy website⁴ and checked each of the top 300 drugs against those covered by the VA formulary. Since the VA formulary is organized by generic entity and only includes the names of brand name drugs when they cannot be substituted due to narrow therapeutic index, all matches were based on the generic name of the drug. For example, the brand name drug Norvasc appears on the list of top 300 drugs; the generic name for Norvasc is amlodipine. As amlodipine is listed on the VA formulary, Norvasc is counted as being on the VA formulary.

However, in some cases, only certain strengths or forms of a particular drug are covered by the VA formulary. In those cases, we looked at the breakdown of script volume by dosage and form for that drug, to the extent allowed by VONA, in order to determine how many scripts are covered on the VA formulary and how many are excluded. In some cases, certain scripts for a particular drug were excluded because that particular formulation (e.g., capsules, extended release version) is not covered.

According to CMS data, the two highest Medicare Part D plans based on 2006 enrollment were the United AARP Medicare Rx Plan and Humana Standard Plan. The FEHBP national plan with greatest enrollment is the Blue Cross Blue Shield FEP Basic plan. We followed a similar approach to compare the two Medicare Part D plan formularies and the BCBS FEP formulary to the list of top 300 drugs. The United AARP Medicare Rx formulary and Humana Standard formulary were obtained from the plans' respective websites.⁵ The FEP basic formulary was obtained from the BCBS Federal Employee Program website.⁶ Again, drugs were matched based on the generic form of the drug. It is important to note that both Medicare plans and the FEHBP plan use a multi-tier copayment structure. For example, the FEHBP formulary uses a three tier structure, with the third tier covering brand name products on formulary that were not

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selected for the second tier and all non-formulary brand name products. Drugs on the third tier have 50% cost sharing, with a minimum payment of \$35.00 or the cost of the drug. As long as the drug is covered on any tier, it is counted as being on formulary.

Key Findings

Exhibit 1 illustrates the number and percent of scripts covered by the VA, FEHBP, and the two Medicare Part D formularies for all of the general drug categories that are captured by the top 300 drugs. The FEHBP and Medicare Part D formularies analyzed all provide a greater breadth of drug coverage than the VA formulary.

- ⇒ Of the 300 drugs examined, 194 (65%) are included in the VA formulary, compared to 284 (95%) in the FEHBP formulary, 282 (94%) in the highest enrollment Part D plan formulary, and 281 (94%) in the second highest enrollment Part D plan formulary. Of 132 brand drugs among the top 300, 56 (42%) are covered by the VA formulary, compared to 125 (95%) covered by the FEHBP formulary, 128 (97%) covered by the highest enrollment Part D plan formulary, and 128 (97%) covered by the second highest enrollment Part D plan formulary.
- ⇒ Of the 761 million scripts analyzed, 71% of the total and 49% of the brand scripts are covered by the VA formulary. In contrast, 98% of all scripts and 98% of brand scripts are covered by the FEHBP plan. The highest enrollment Part D plan covers 96% of all scripts and 99% of brand scripts and the second highest enrollment Part D plan covers 95% of all scripts and 99% of brand scripts.
- ⇒ VA formulary coverage varies widely among the drug categories due to the partially closed nature of the formulary; for example while 75% of all scripts are covered in the largest category (cardiovascular), fewer than half of scripts for ear, nose, and throat and urologic disorders would be covered.

Exhibit 2 illustrates the formulary status for each of the top 300 drugs.
