## **Join Letter Urging the House Leadership to Defund ObamaCare**

Dear Colleague,

I write today to ask you to join me in sending a letter to Speaker Boehner and Leader Cantor urging them to de-fund the implementation and enforcement of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act in any relevant appropriations bill brought to the House floor in the 113<sup>th</sup> Congress, including any continuing appropriations bill.

In the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress, **127 members** of Congress signed a letter to the republican leadership during appropriations season, urging them to defund ObamaCare. In light of the recent Internal Revenue Service (IRS) scandal, it is imperative, now more than ever, that Congress do everything in its power to halt the implementation of the healthcare law. It is entirely unacceptable that the IRS, a government agency that actively discriminates against Americans, is in charge of implementing a law that Americans do not want.

Since much of the implementation of ObamaCare is a function of the discretionary appropriations process, including the operation of the “ mandatory spending” portions of the law, Congress must

exercise its power to de-fund the implementation and enforcement of Obamacare.
