## **Hearing Notice: Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations**

The Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations has scheduled a hearing on Wednesday, March 21, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in room 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The title of the hearing is "The Center for Consumer Information and Insurance Oversight and the Anniversary of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act." Witnesses to be announced.

The Center for Consumer Information and Insurance Oversight oversees many aspects of the health care law's implementation, including the waiver process, the nearly bankrupt Early Retiree Reinsurance Program, and the recently released exchange regulations. In light of CBO's new analysis that reveals the health care law's gross cost is \$1.8 trillion and fewer Americans will be able to maintain their current employer-sponsored health insurance, the hearing will examine the status of the many lofty promises made by the law's proponents.
