



## 2010 Congressional Elections

November 3, 2010

The preliminary results of the November 2 elections show that Republicans have gained control of the House of Representatives and Democrats have retained a narrow majority in the Senate.

This paper includes the following information:

- the composition of the 112th Congress (2011-2012);
- an overview of races that are still too close to call;
- a list of incumbent Senate and House members who have been defeated; and
- a list of newly elected lawmakers.

### Outlook

Looking forward to 2011, the health reform debates in the new political environment will focus on implementation of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) and efforts to change or repeal the new law. While efforts to repeal ACA will face a presidential veto, lawmakers also will pursue incremental changes. In addition, the annual appropriations process is likely to serve as a battleground for debating ACA issues, including the amount of funding that will be appropriated to support federal agencies involved in the implementation process.

Congressional hearings also are likely to focus on implementation issues, including the impact of the immediate reforms on costs and coverage, the outlook for the major reforms that take effect in 2014, and more direct oversight of federal regulators.

Recognizing that the new Congress will include a large class of freshman lawmakers in both the Senate and the House, it is important for our community to reach out to these newly elected officials to establish working relationships. These initial outreach efforts will be critical to informing them about the economic role played by specific health plans in their states and congressional districts, as well as health plans' role as a resource on the many health care issues they will face in their new positions.
