**ORDER**

Before the Court is the plaintiff's unopposed Notice Regarding Developments in the Administrative Proceeding and Request for Stay. Dkt. No. 19. The plaintiff informs the Court that the Secretary of Labor withdrew the administrative citation and complaint, and the ALJ terminated the case. *Id.* at 1; *see also* Dkt. No. 19-1. The ALJ's order likely will become final 30 days from the date it was issued (July 22, 2025). Dkt. No. 19-1 at 2–3. Therefore, the plaintiff requests that this Court stay the summary-judgment briefing schedule (Dkt. No. 18) pending the finalization of the ALJ's termination order—which will presumably resolve the case before this Court in its entirety as well. Dkt. No. 19 at 2.

Construing the plaintiff's unopposed notice and request to stay as a motion to stay the briefing schedule, the motion (Dkt. No. 19) is granted. The briefing schedule for summary-judgment motions (Dkt. No. 18) is hereby stayed and held in abeyance pending the final termination of the underlying administrative proceeding. The parties are ordered to submit a joint status report or a joint stipulation of dismissal no later than August 25, 2025.
