Speaker Boehner Hails Senate Passage of Pledge to America Legislation Repealing ObamaCare's Job-Crushing 1099 Mandate

WASHINGTON, DC – House Speaker John Boehner (R-OH) today commended Senate passage of [Pledge to America](#) legislation (H.R. 4) to repeal the job-destroying 1099 small business paperwork mandate in ObamaCare:

"I'm pleased the Senate has followed the new House majority's lead in passing this Pledge to America bill to repeal the health care law's 1099 small business paperwork mandate, which is making it harder for small businesses to create jobs. I hope President Obama will sign this common-sense reform into law to help give small business owners some measure of relief from the law's onslaught of mandates, taxes, and penalties that – by their own account - are making it difficult for them to plan ahead, grow their businesses and create American jobs. Now we need to repeal the rest of the law. The new House majority has already voted to repeal and defund the law in its entirety, and will continue working to repeal and replace it with better solutions to bring down costs and protect jobs."
