1 At the end of title XI, add the following:

2 **SEC. 11 \_\_\_\_ . PROGRAM FOR LABELING OF FISH THAT HAVE**

3 **NOT BEEN GENETICALLY-ENGINEERED.**

4 Chapter IV (21 U.S.C. 341 et seq.) is amended by  
5 adding at the end the following:

6 **"SEC. 424. PROGRAM FOR LABELING OF FISH THAT HAVE**

7 **NOT BEEN GENETICALLY-ENGINEERED.**

8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish a  
9 certification program for producers and handlers of fish  
10 products that have not been genetically engineered. If a

1 producer or handler is certified under the program, such  
2 producer or handler may label the fish products produced  
3 or handled by such person as not genetically engineered.

4 “(b) CONSULTATION AND ACCOMMODATION.—In car-  
5 rying out subsection (a), the Secretary shall consult  
6 with—

7 “(1) the Secretary of Agriculture;

8 “(2) the Secretary of Commerce;

9 “(3) fishermen; and

10 “(4) other interested members of the public.

11 “(c) CERTIFICATION.—The Secretary shall imple-  
12 ment the program established under subsection (a)  
13 through certifying agents. Such certifying agents may cer-  
14 tify a producer or handler of fish only if such producer  
15 or handler does not use genetically-engineered processes.”.
