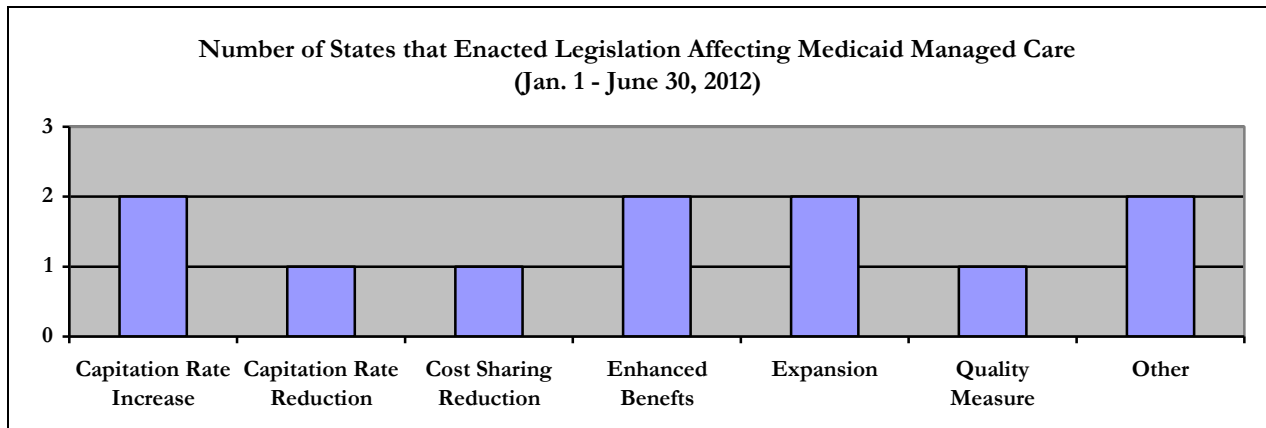


## Medicaid Managed Care

**Eight states enacted legislation that affects Medicaid managed care.**



Enacted Legislation Impacting Managed Care			
State	Subject	Bill Number	Summary
CA	Expansion	A 1467	Expands managed care to Medicaid beneficiaries in rural regions of the state
CA	Expansion	A 1494	Eliminates the state's CHIP program and transfers beneficiaries into Medicaid managed care over a 12-month period, beginning January 2013
CA	Enhance benefits	S 1036	Beginning March 2013, makes in-home support services a Medicaid managed care benefit in specified counties
FL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Capitation rate reduction</li> <li>• Capitation rate increase</li> </ul>	H 5001	Reduces Medicaid health plan capitation rates by 5.64 percent; increases capitation rates for CHIP managed care plans

<b>MI</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Capitation rate increase</li> <li>• Expansion</li> </ul>	H 5365	Increases capitation rates from 1.5-1.25 percent for managed care plans; expands the geographic coverage area of the Medicaid managed care dental program for children
<b>MN</b>	Cost sharing reduction	H 2294	Allows Medicaid managed care plans to waive the family deductible, beginning Jan. 1, 2012
<b>NY</b>	Enhance benefits	A 9056	Requires Medicaid managed care plans to offer personal assistance programs to chronically ill or physically disabled enrollees
<b>OH</b>	Other	H 487	Excludes children with cystic fibrosis, hemophilia or cancer who receive services through the medically-handicapped children's program from being enrolled in Medicaid managed care for a specified time period
<b>UT</b>	Quality measure	H 98	Authorizes the use of incentives in Medicaid managed care contracts to encourage beneficiaries to seek appropriate care in appropriate settings
<b>WV</b>	Other	H 4438	Authorizes the state to enter into contracts with provider-sponsored networks and offer the networks as enrollment options for Medicaid beneficiaries
