- Individuals ineligible for AFDC for reasons that don't apply for Medicaid - §435.113
- Individuals who would be eligible for AFDC but for increase in OASDI in 1972 - §435.114
- Individuals deemed to be receiving AFDC - §435.115(a) – (d)
- Qualified Family Members - 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(V) – §435.119

Optional

- Individuals who would be eligible for AFDC but for child care expenses - 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(II) – §435.220
- Individuals who would be eligible for AFDC if the IV-A plan were as broad as allowed 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(III) – §435.223
