AAN's Sen. Coleman: "There's Still Time to Actually Improve our Health Care System - Beginning With the Repeal of Obamacare"

American Action Forum Briefs Cited in Dissenting Opinion

WASHINGTON - American Action Network Chairman Sen. Norm Coleman issued the following statement following the Supreme Court's ruling on the constitutionality of Obamacare today:

"The Supreme Court made clear today that Obamacare is a massive tax and we know it will have devastating economic impacts on millions of Americans. While the decision of the court is disappointing, it's important that all Americans accept the judgment of our nation's highest court. The American Action Forum, and the countless economists who supported its amicus briefs, can take pride in their efforts, which were cited multiple times by the Supreme Court in today's dissenting opinion. Obamacare is a danger to the fiscal security of America and failed to provide the type of health care reform America desperately needs. This onerous law threatens good private coverage for families, robbed \$500 billion from seniors to pay for part of it, and will leave a legacy of debt to our children and grandchildren. I believe Congress must repeal Obamacare and replace it with commonsense incremental steps that increase Americans access to quality, affordable health care that meets their needs - not the mandate of the federal government. There's still time to actually improve our health care system - beginning with the repeal of Obamacare."
