**CONGRESSMAN FARR STATEMENT ON GOP 2013
BUDGET**

WASHINGTON, DC –Congressman Sam Farr (D-Carmel) released the following statement after the release of the House Republican FY2013 budget:

“The House Republican budget released today only offers more of the same: ending Medicare as we know it and more tax cuts for the wealthiest in America. This budget was already rejected once by the American people. We frankly have too much work ahead of us to go through this Republican song and dance show one more time.

Instead of sponsoring a new sideshow, the Republican House Leadership should stick to their word and honor the budget agreement reached last year. Democrats are committed to getting our fiscal house in order, and we stand ready to work with Republicans on a fair and balanced approach that creates jobs in the short term and well into the future.”
